- Ensure teachers provide effective differentiation and engagement, across all learning areas and for all students.
- Ensuring the school has a quality and consistent whole school curriculum plan through the 3 levels of planning.
- Further build staff capacity and capability in understanding and enacting 'The Science of Reading'.

Our initiatives include

- Teachers working closely with the Head of Department - Curriculum and their peers to provide curriculum at the students level of entitlement, including students with Individual Curriculum Plans, via such as, but not limited to, 'release days', Professional Development, coaching, collegial planning and peer to peer mentoring. Purchase of virtual reality 'stations' to aid student engagement and independent learning.
- Enact and embed all stages of Cecil Plains State School Moderation Policy and Procedure document.
- Implementation of Initial Lit and MacqLit, refining and embedding reading data collection processes and continued use of our reading inquiry cycle.
